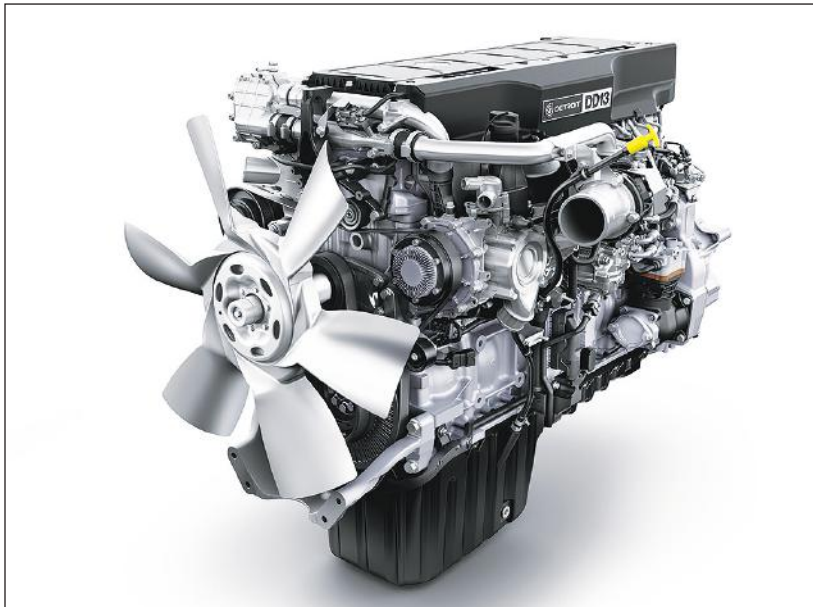

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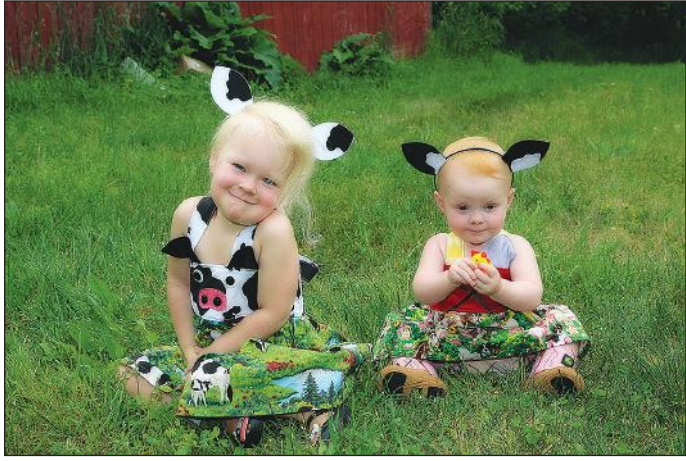
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Off The Beaten Path

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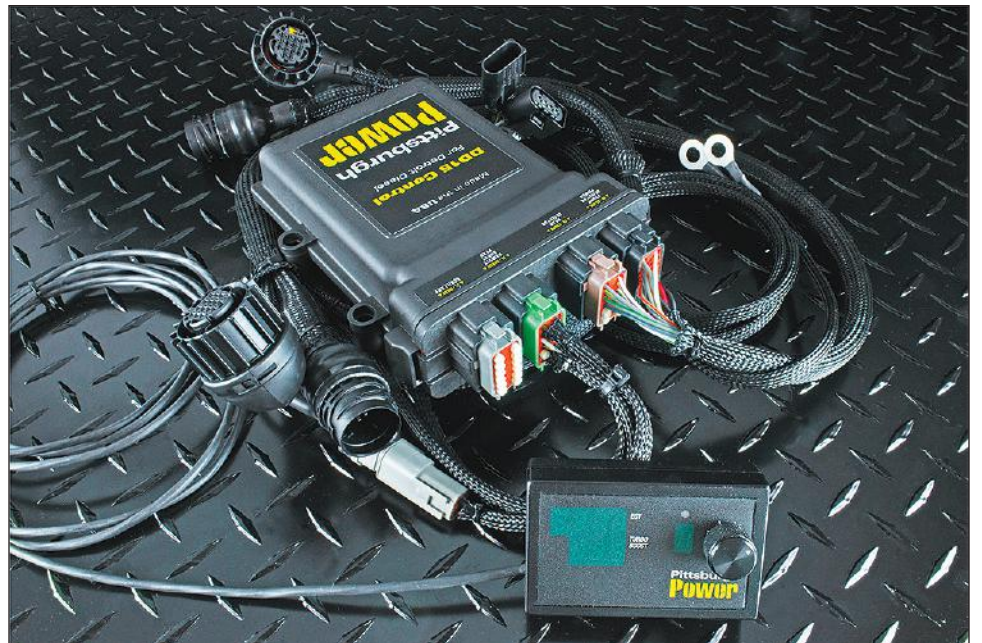

The Dallas Truck Show: Even though the show's attendance overall was down slightly, our booth was always filled with owner-operators. There is a tremendous amount of interest growing in our ability to equip you or your favorite shop with our remote tuning suitcase. In this suitcase are a laptop computer and all of the necessary equipment to connect to Cummins, Caterpillar, and Detroit Diesel engines so that we can program and troubleshoot engines regardless of where they are located via remote access. The ability to do this troubleshooting has benefited several small fleets



running both new glider kits AND new trucks. As a result, NOW, when a check-engine light comes on, you no longer have to take the truck to a truck dealership! Just give us a call. Typically, we will just instruct you to plug the computer into the data port and we will then tell you what the problem is and what you need to do in order to make the necessary repairs. Do you need more horsepower and torque? There's NO problem there: You're just a phone call away. We have dealers set up in Chicago, Phoenix, North Texas, Orlando, Kansas City, and Oregon. So, SOON, those of you not all that geographically

close to Pittsburgh will have more locations where you can find more of what Pittsburgh Power has to offer. Pittsburgh Power Custom computer programming designed (and tested) by our engineers (original engine manufacturers' programs will naturally also be available) will be available without having to travel to Western Pennsylvania.

The "variable geometry turbochargers" on the 12.7-liter DD4 Detroit's are not only gaining tremendous power, but the fuel mileage is up about 0.75 miles per gallon. Horsepower at 1200 RPM, you ask?! How about 600 to the



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ground (which is 705 flywheel HP)! The torque is 1800 foot-pounds! That is a remarkable achievement for a 12.7-liter engine. Even though we CAN give you that much power at such a low RPM, you should STILL pull the hills and mountains above 1400 RPM. As always, your boost gauge and pyrometer will tell you where you need to be... This IS an expensive conversion - somewhere between \$6,000 and \$7,000. At an increase of 0.75 miles per gallon, the payback time will be about 1 year at today's fuel prices, and that timeline shrinks if prices rise. Basically, this is a result of the "V.G." Turbo's ability to offer both the quicker spool-up of a small turbo along with the higher output of the larger turbo.

To the owners of DD15 Detroit's: The Pittsburgh Powerbox IS NOW available for your engine!! This is truly a plug-and-play set-up. In fact, the computer mounts under the hood, so the only hole required in the firewall is for the remote control. The computer has 7 power settings and produces 25 horsepower per setting and 50 pound feet of torque for a total of 175 horsepower and 350 additional pound feet of torque (on the max level, level 7). The beauty of the Powerbox has always been the fact that you can change the horsepower and torque as you drive (on-the-fly!), and you can also turn it back to stock horsepower if you're in snow or ice. If you have to put a driver in your truck you can turn it to zero or power level 1 (or any

other level) and unplug the remote. Without the remote, he/she cannot change the settings. The operator will only be able to choose to leave it on its current level or switch the unit off, rendering the engine back to stock (or level 0). You can also take the box to another truck (provided it also has a dd-15 or dd-16 engine), if need be.

Another DD-15 performance enhancement developed by the engineering staff at Pittsburgh Power is our emissions-compliant performance tune (programming). The horsepower can be set up to 600 horsepower to the ground which equates to 705 horsepower to the flywheel and 1950 foot pound of torque to the rear wheels which is 2294 foot pound of torque at the flywheel. If you don't need this much power, all you have to do is tell us what it IS that you desire! It's your truck and your decision, and engineering is very flexible with their abilities! Now, the advantage to the Powerbox verses the performance tune is the fact that you can adjust it while you

drive. The performance tune is adjusted with your right foot (only). Either way of gaining horsepower and torque along with fuel mileage will put a smile on your face and you will have a deeper appreciation of your truck. When you think about your life with your truck, isn't that what we want, a good running tuck that is legal, gets great fuel mileage and does not break down.

Now that we are able to improve the reliability of the emissions systems on the new trucks, increase the response, horsepower and torque along with improving fuel mileage, you can feel comfortable purchasing a brand new truck equipped with a Cummins, Detroit, or Paccar engine. Now you will start to see the prices of used trucks prior to 2008 decline because the 2008 to present trucks are now reliable with our help.

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The Lighting Basics: Lighting Legality – Lens Codes - Part 1

This month and next month, we are going to look at the letters molded into the lenses of lights. This month will cover the parameters for an SAE Code, while next month will be examples of decoding parts using a table they have provided. The following information has been sourced via an official SAE document written in 1995 and approved for unlimited distribution found posted on law.resource.org. I will have the link at the bottom of this article for your reading pleasure.

It should be said right off the bat that the SAE itself does not “approve” or “endorse items.”

An SAE code must meet the following requirements:

- Markings must be permanent on lens or body (typically part of the production process).
- Markings must be observable and readable.

• Markings must have “manufacturer identification and model designation.” An example would be “KD 516.”

• Letters must be 2mm or 3mm (there are exceptions)

• The code itself.

The SAE Code is made up of the following 4 parts:

- SAE
- A number within a circle or parentheses indicating the number of compartments in a multicompartment device or the number of separate lamps when more than one compartment... No number is required for a single compartment device.”

• “One or more letters identifying the function or functions for which the device was designed. Multipurpose devices shall be marked to cover each function for which the device was originally designed. Such devices may be used to carry out one

or more of these functions.”

• “The last two numbers of a year which means that the code letters refer to SAE Specifications listed in the SAE Handbook current in the year indicated, or the applicable requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 108 specified for the device function in the year indicated. To denote that a function meets the requirements of FMVSS 108, but not the current SAE Specification, a dash line shall be placed under the function letter.”

I hope this article gave you a little more insight into the letters on the lens of your light.

Understanding Oil Contaminants

Let's start with an update on the new diesel motor oil categories. After five years of testing between the oil companies, the American Petroleum Institute (API) and the engine manufacturers the API has approved the oil for sale. The proposed category PC-11 has been divided into two new categories CK-4 that will replace the current CJ-4 oil designed for current engines and FA-4 that is designed for engines built in 2017. API CK-4 and FA-4 will hit the market December 1, 2016 and can be identified by the API Donut symbol on the back of the oil container. Both oils are formulated to improve fuel economy and provide additional protection from oxidation, engine wear, the effects of low and high temperatures and carbon deposits. These improvements should help extend oil drains by maintaining satisfactory oil quality etc.

Here are a few questions that were submitted:

I have an increase in viscosity and oxidation coupled with a sizeable decrease in total base number (TBN). What could be causing this combination? The answer is

HEAT, the oil is overheating that causes an increase in chemical reaction that adds oxides to oil and causes the base additives calcium, magnesium, phosphorous to lose potency. The added heat will cook the oil causing it to thicken and the viscosity will increase. The cause of the excess heat can be as simple as running with low oil levels, a defective oil cooler, or restricted flow in oil galleys or turbo charger. The low level of oil does not allow the oil to cool in oil pan before starting a new oil cycle through engine. A blocked oil cooler will not allow the oil to dissipate heat and restrictive flow keeps oil in engine longer increasing heat levels.

My oil sample has high potassium but very little sodium that would indicate an antifreeze contamination of my oil. Where could it be coming from? Potassium is a major ingredient in preservative compounds that are used to protect engine parts from corroding while on the shelf. Usually when I see this I ask if any parts that come in contact with the oil have been replaced recently i.e. oil coolers, turbo chargers, oil pans, charge air coolers (potassium with aluminum) etc. If no parts have been replaced, then the contamination could be environmental or from an oil additive.

My oil sample results were showing high fuel dilution that caused my viscosity to drop a grade. I added a viscosity stabilizer to bring the viscosity up to correct grade. Am I putting my engine at risk for failure? While the viscosity stabilizer will bring the oil back up to the

proper grade, you are just masking a fuel dilution issue that eventually will cause serious damage to the engine. Bear in mind that most oil analysis labs will not perform a Gas Chromatography test if the viscosity is within the parameters for your grade of oil. They will report a < 1% level based on the viscosity level without actually testing for fuel dilution. Therefore you would never know you have fuel dilution that is eroding the wear metal additive package in your oil that protects metal-to-metal wear. Gas Chromatography will report the actual level of fuel dilution in spite of the viscosity levels. I have seen fuel dilution at over 10% with a viscosity of 14.5 on a SAE15W40 oil (12.3-16.2) that would not have detected a serious fuel contamination issue. I find it is always best to fix a problem rather than mask it to avoid engine failures.

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ATA Truck Tonnage Index Fell 2.1% in July

Arlington, VA... American Trucking Associations' advanced seasonally adjusted (SA) For-Hire Truck Tonnage Index decreased 2.1% in July, following a revised 1.6% decline during June. In July, the index equaled 134.3 (2000=100), down from 137.1 in June. The all-time high was 144 in February.

Compared with July 2015, the SA index rose just 0.3%, the smallest year-over-year gain in 2016. In June, the year-over-year increase was 2.1%. Year-to-date, compared with the same period in 2015, tonnage was up 3.2%.

The not seasonally adjusted index, which represents the change in tonnage actually hauled by the fleets before any seasonal adjust-

ment, equaled 138.2 in July, which was 2.7% below the previous month (142).

"On a monthly basis, tonnage has decreased in four of the last five months and stood

at the lowest level since October during July," said ATA Chief Economist Bob Costello. "This prolonged softness is consistent with a supply chain that is clearing out elevated inventories.

"Looking ahead, expect a softer and uneven truck freight environment until the inventory correction is complete. With moderate economic growth expected, truck freight will improve the further along the inventory cycle we progress," he said.

Trucking serves as a barometer

of the U.S. economy, representing 68.8% of tonnage carried by all modes of domestic freight transportation, including manufactured and retail goods. Trucks hauled just under 10 billion tons of freight in 2014. Motor carriers collected \$700.4 billion, or 80.3% of total revenue earned by all transport modes.

ATA calculates the tonnage index based on surveys from its membership and has been doing so since the 1970s. This is a preliminary figure and subject to change in the final report issued around the 10th day of the month. The report includes month-to-month and year-over-year results, relevant economic comparisons and key financial indicators.

Bendix Extends Customer Service Center Hours

ELYRIA, OH... To better serve its customers, Bendix is extending the hours of its North American Customer Service Centers and enabling bilingual access to Customer Service representatives via its automated phone menu. Effective Aug. 22, 2016, representatives will be available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., Eastern Time. The extension means that customers in the East can reach a representative by phone three hours later than currently, and customers in the West - who formerly accessed their rep via a West Coast service location - can reach a Bendix team member three hours earlier. In addition, a step is being removed from the automated

menu. To be connected to the next available rep, customers will dial 1-800-AIR-BRAKE (1-800-247-2725), select option 1, and then select 1 for English or 2 for French. A Spanish language option is also on tap for later in 2016.

Bendix is also updating segments of its order placement process, effective Aug. 22. For customers in the United States and outside of Quebec province in Canada, the email address for orders is changing to orders@bendix.com. The existing email address will remain in place for a short transition period, during which orders received will automatically forward to the new address. The email change affects those customers not currently

setup to place orders via Bendix's EDI or website (bendix.biz). The number for fax orders is also changing to (260) 356-0506. For customers within Quebec province, the process for submitting orders will not change: email orders to MLT-CustomerService@bendix.com or fax them to 1 (514) 323-1352.

Driver Turnover Falls for Carriers in Second Quarter Due to Sluggish Market

Driver turnover fell four points year-over-year for larger truckload fleets to 83% in the second quarter, dropping to the lowest level since 2011 amid a sluggish freight market, American Trucking Association reported Sept. 1.

Turnover at the smaller truckload fleets, or those with \$30 million or less in revenue, fell nine points to 79%, the lowest level in three quarters sequentially, but ticked up three percentage points year-over-year. For larger fleets, with \$30 million or more in revenue, the rate dropped six points from the first quarter to 83%.

"The continued decline in the turnover rate reflects the continued choppiness in the freight economy," said ATA Chief Economist Bob Costello. "As we hopefully approach the end of this period of elevated inventories later this year, freight demand will pick back up leading to increased demand for drivers and higher turnover rates in the future." However, he added that despite the fall in turnover rates, the driver shortage remains a concern for many motor carriers.

ATA President Chris Spear Calls Rhode Island Truck-Only Toll 'Extortion'

American Trucking Association's new president, Chris Spear, jumped headfirst into the conflict between the Rhode Island Trucking Association and Gov. Gina Raimondo on Aug. 24.

Spear labeled RhodeWorks, Raimondo's trucks-only tolls plan, "extortion" in a meeting in Riverside, Rhode Island, with members of the state association and other business people opposed to the plan.

"We don't know if this program is legal, but it is bad policy and an extortion of our industry," Spear said. Rhode Island Trucking Association President Christopher Maxwell echoed Spear's comments about RhodeWorks, which would require commercial trucks - but not other vehicles - to pay \$3 at each of 14 toll booths around the state up to a maximum of \$20 per day.

New Route Brings Cargo to Philadelphia via Bigger Panama Canal and 'Panamax' Ships

With the long-awaited \$5.4 billion Panama Canal expansion completed and allowing bigger ships to carry more cargo through the waterway, some of those larger vessels are coming to the Port of Philadelphia.

Mediterranean Shipping Co. began a new freight route Aug. 3, hauling fruit and "dry" cargoes such as tires, wood products, wine, sugar, and cocoa beans from Chile and Peru through the canal's new traffic lane, with a stop in Freeport, Bahamas, and then in Philadelphia.

The Philadelphia Regional Port Authority, which owns 15 piers

and terminals on the Delaware River, puts the economic impact of MSC's new route at \$21.8 million in annual personal income and \$5.7 million in state, local, and federal taxes.

Tech Talk: Michigan may let driverless cars cruise public roads w/o human operator

Michigan may become the first state to let driverless cars on the road without any human driver behind the wheel. State legislators have introduced a bill that would let companies developing the self-driving technology operate their vehicles on the road without a test driver present.

Most major automakers and some major tech companies, including Google and Uber, are

developing autonomous cars and testing them on public roads. But currently, all states require a human driver to be behind the wheel in case they need to take over.

US Proposes Mandatory Speed Limiter Devices

The federal government is proposing that heavy-duty vehicles be equipped with devices that limit their speeds on

U.S. roadways but said the limiters will not be required to be tamper-proof.

The proposal, announced Aug. 26, discusses the benefits of setting the maximum speed at 60, 65, and 68 miles per hour but said a final rule could differ, depending on public input and vehicle tests to

determine a speed limit for specific vehicle types.

Comments on the proposed rule will be accepted for 60 days after publication in the Federal Register. The rule wouldn't be effective until three years after the final rule is published in the register.

The joint proposal of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and National Highway Traffic Safety Administration said limiting the speeds of heavy vehicles will save lives and injuries, cut fuel costs and reduce greenhouse gases and other pollutants.

"This is basic physics," NHTSA Administrator Mark Rosekind said in a statement. "Even small increases in speed have large effects on the force of impact. Setting the speed limit on heavy vehicles makes sense for safety and the environment."

FMCSA Seeking Comment on Medical Review Board's Diabetes Recommendation

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration is seeking public comment on a slate of guidelines recommended by the agency's medical experts for drivers with diabetes to operate commercial motor vehicles. FMCSA's medical review board guidelines follow a

May 2015 proposed rule that would allow drivers with diabetes mellitus to be qualified to operate CMVs in interstate commerce.

The notice of proposed rulemaking would enable individuals with the condition to obtain a medical examiner's certificate at least annually. The stipulation is that evidence is presented by the treating clinician that the driver's condition is stable and well-controlled.

General regulatory requirements deem a person physically qualified to drive a CMV only if that person has no established medical history or clinical diagnosis of diabetes mellitus currently requiring insulin for control. However, since 2003, FMCSA has maintained an exemption program for individuals that use insulin to treat diabetes.

DOT Awards \$759 Million in FASTLANE Transportation Grants

The U.S. Department of Transportation has announced grants totaling more than \$759 million to support 18 transportation infrastructure projects in 15 states and the District of Columbia.

The first round of grant awards were part of the Fostering Advancements in Shipping and Transportation for the Long-term

Achievement of National Efficiencies program, or FASTLANE.

From 2016-2020, the FASTLANE grant program is authorized to award \$4.5 billion in dedicated funding for projects of national or regional significance that address major issues facing the nation's highways and bridges.

DOT said the grants, authorized in the 2015 FAST Act, for the first time establish broad, multiyear eligibilities for freight infrastructure, including intermodal projects.

Most state lawmakers who backed gas tax hike won their primaries

The Hill Reports, almost all lawmakers who supported legislation to raise their state's gasoline tax last year won their primaries in 2016, according to an analysis from the American Road and Transportation Builders Association (ARTBA).

But raising the federal gas tax, which hasn't been done in two decades, is still seen as politically unpopular.

Iowa, South Dakota, Utah, Idaho, Georgia, Nebraska, Washington, and Michigan all passed a fuel tax increase or something similar in 2015.

Ninety-eight percent of the lawmakers who backed those increases and were up for re-election came out victorious in primary races this year, according to ARTBA's Transportation Investment Advocacy Center.

Six of those states had a Republican governor and GOP-led legislature.

Tech Talk: Uber Is Betting We'll See Driverless 18-Wheelers Before Taxis

In a battered warehouse in San Francisco, Uber is working on what it thinks will be a shortcut in the race to make money from vehicles that drive themselves. A fleet of six modified white Volvo truck cabs operate out of a brick building in the SoMa district popular with technology startups.

Around the clock, at least one of the vehicles is steering itself around Bay Area highways.

(Tech Talk) Alphabet and Chipotle Are Bringing Burrito Delivery Drones to Campus

In what's sure to be a college student's dream come true, drones will soon be delivering burritos on the campus of Virginia Tech.

The experimental service, to begin this month and last just a few weeks, is a test by Project Wing, a unit of Google's parent company Alphabet Inc.

Chipotle Mexican Grill Inc. and the Blacksburg, Virginia, university have agreed to participate.

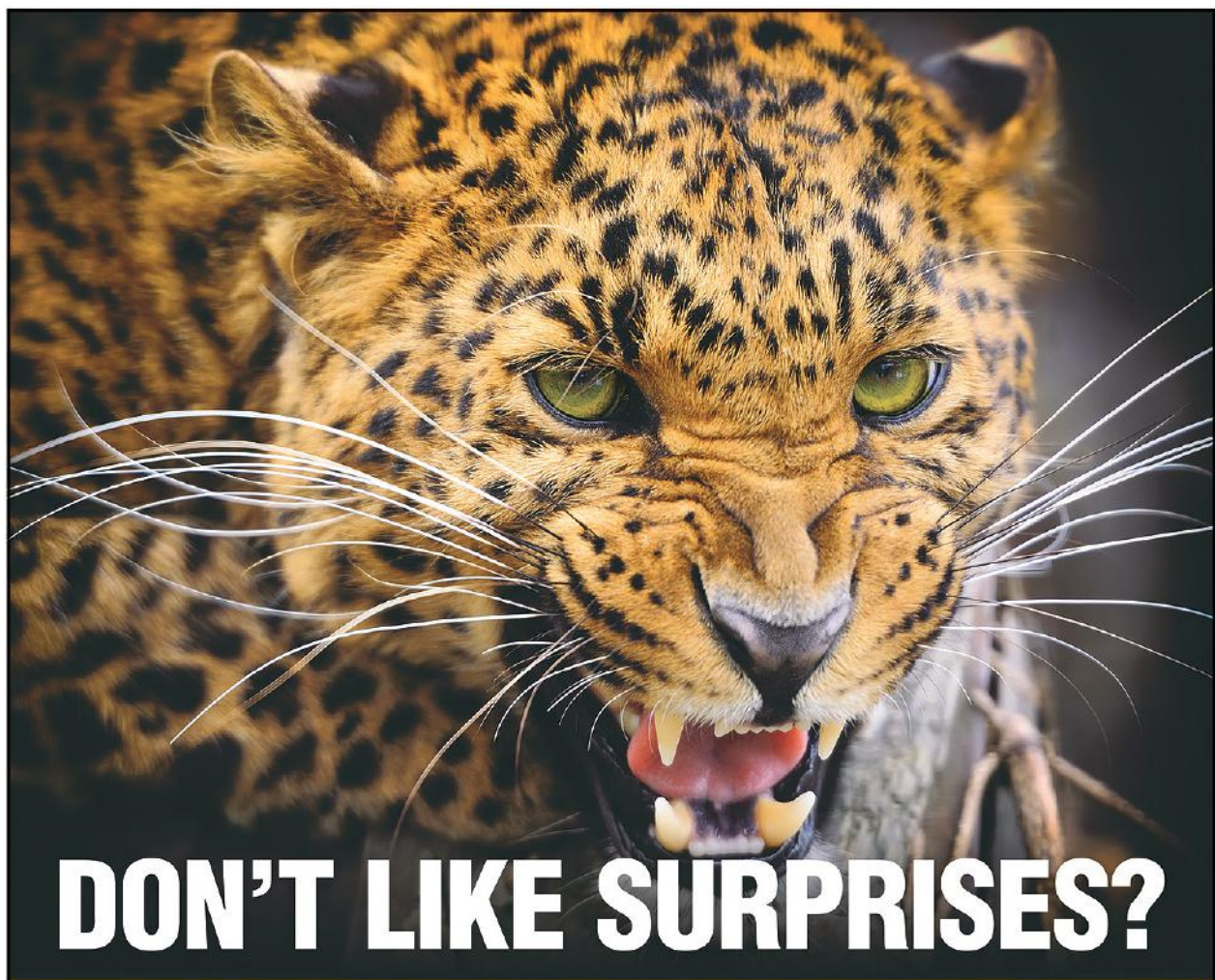

Amazon has begun a round of trials at a location in the U.K.

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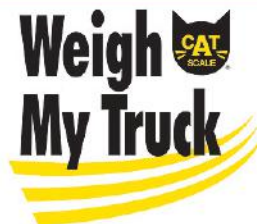

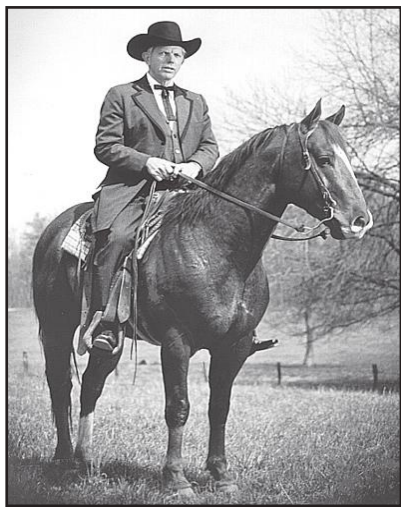

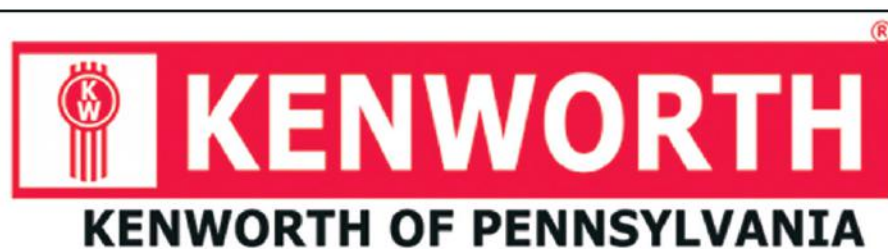

Trucking Leaders Against Dangerous Mandate For Speed Limiting Devices On Large Trucks

Grain Valley, MO... A national association of small-business truckers says the government's proposal to mandate speed limiting devices on large trucks would be dangerous for all highway users. The Owner-Operator Independent Drivers Association, the nation's only organization representing professional and small-business truckers, says such devices create speed differentials that lead to more crashes and promote road rage among other motorists.

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration announced today a notice of proposed rulemaking. It would require U.S. trucks larger than 26,000 pounds and ECU equipped, approximate model year 2000 and newer, be set at a maximum speed of 60 or 65 or 68 miles per hour. The notice says the agency will consider other speeds based on public input.

"Highways are safest when all vehicles travel at the same relative speed," said Todd Spencer. "This wisdom has always been true and has not ever changed."

The Association also points out that speed limit devices actually take control out of the hands of drivers in that there are a number of scenarios that require drivers to accelerate in order to avoid danger.

"No technology can replace the safest thing to put in a truck, which is a well-trained driver," concluded Spencer.

The Owner-Operator Independent Drivers Association is the only national trade association representing the interests of small-business trucking professionals and professional truck drivers. The Association currently has more than 157,000 members nationwide. OOIDA was established in 1973 and is headquartered in the Greater Kansas City, Mo., area.

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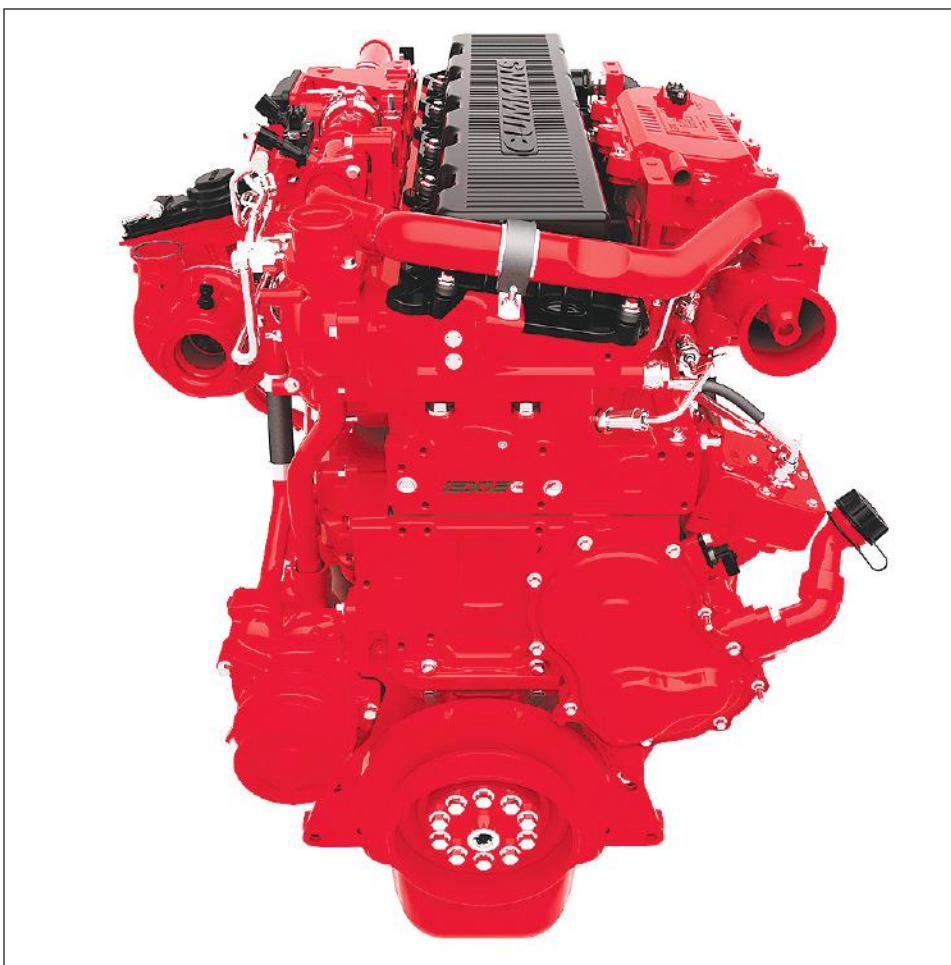

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This Machine Does Not Have A Brain, Use Yours: Parts Changers And Technicians Part 1:

In the 80's it was said that ECMs using OBD (On board diagnostics) would put technicians out of a job. A computer would do the task of diagnostics and it would do everything to fix itself besides turn a wrench. How did that work out? Technology is supposed to make life easier and simpler but when you compare a new ISX to an old beige big cam do things look simpler and easier? ECMs all have an on board diagnostics system. Is it useful? Absolutely. Is it perfect? Not even close. I hear lots of guys refer to the ECM as the brain box. Take it from someone who has disassembled hundreds and programmed thousands...there is no brain in there. The diagnostic systems on ECMs are more limited than most people realize. That's why the need for technicians who use their head to find problems in this industry has never been greater. I've worked alongside great technicians and I've worked with guys who just pull codes and change parts. The difference tends to be if they are using their brain or not.

Do you need a computer to tell you that you have a miss? If you know your truck you don't. You can hear it, you can feel it, and you know something isn't right. A parts changer isn't going to be interested in talking to you. He's going to plug in, pull codes, and basically do what the computer tells him to do. If the computer doesn't tell him what's wrong or he changes it out for his test DDEC III with tons of timing advance in it then he will

say the ECM is bad and change the computer because that's what parts changers do. There is a lot of profit in the parts business so there isn't much corporate incentive to change this. Also good technicians are expensive, hard to replace, and increasingly hard to find. Many are from before the days when there was an ECM on the engine. These guys had to rely on their eyes, ears, a toolbox full of testing equipment and their brain to find problems. The best techs out there combine their knowledge with the diagnostic information from the ECM. They realize that the ECM's diagnostics has limitations and they don't let it do the thinking for them. Imagine you have a DDEC IV that won't start. Most of the time a DDEC IV will not log a code in this situation. If a DDEC IV loses unswitched power, the ignition input, or both timing signals no fault code will be logged. If it's power related it won't communicate. Also Series 60 engines with DDECIVs do not have a fuel pressure sensor. A technician will know what fuel pressure was when he tried to crank the engine. If the engine didn't have an ECM the fuel pressure would be the first thing checked in a no start situation. A parts changer who relies on the ECM to do his thinking isn't going to know what the fuel pressure is. Check back next month for the next part of this article.

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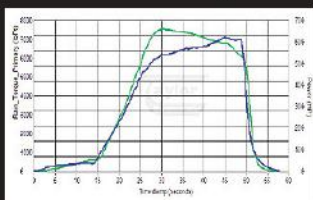
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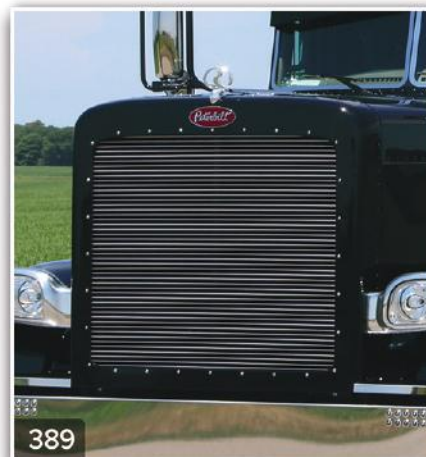

Road Flooded? Don't Drive Through It!

Floods can happen anywhere. Even places you wouldn't expect can become flooded if conditions are right. In recent months, Texas has been particularly hard-hit with major flooding in both Dallas and Houston. Now West Virginia is seeing some terrible flooding. Whether it's heavy rain or the aftermath of a hurricane, no matter what city you live in the effects of a flood can be damaging!

While flooding is dangerous in any location, it can be particularly deadly when it occurs on roadways. Drivers often underestimate the depth of the water and how little it takes to completely sweep away a vehicle (even a large truck). Here are 6 reasons why you should never drive through flooded

roads.

There may not be a road
 Floodwaters from a swollen river can have a very powerful current and can wash away entire swaths of road. This damage can be hidden from view under just a few inches of water and can mean the difference between making it to the other side and being stuck in fast-moving flood waters with a car that won't work. What's more, it could mean your life as the soft ground under the water could cause your car to begin sinking.

It doesn't take much for your tires to lose traction

Tires are designed to maintain traction only on rain-covered roadways. As little as an inch can cause the tires to lose traction completely. That means your tires could begin to spin and that there's next to nothing keeping your car from being swept away. And while cars are very heavy, many can begin to float in one foot of water. Couple that with the loss of traction, and you've got nowhere to go.

It doesn't take much to damage your car

Even if the water is less than a foot deep, the potential for significant damage to your car still exists. On most passenger cars, six inches of water is enough to threaten your car's exhaust system and air intake. Once water gets in there, your car can stall and become irreparably damaged. Is it worth the thousands of dollars it would take to replace a busted engine or buy a new car just to save a minute or two? Don't drive through a flooded road. Turn around and find another way to get to your destination.

Two feet can carry you away

Two feet of water may not seem like much and, if it's not moving water, you might be able to make it through (though we don't recommend it). But if the water is moving, stay away! Those two feet of water can sweep away pretty much any vehicle regardless of size and drivetrain (see first video above). Four-wheel drive isn't going to do much good if your car has lost all traction and is now floating, even just an eighth-of-an-inch above the surface of the road. Once your vehicle has lost contact with the road, it's at the mercy of the current.

Danger often lies beside a flooded road

That moving water on the road might not be very deep and it might not be moving very fast, but think about where it's going for a moment. Remember that it doesn't take much for moving water to get your car going somewhere that you don't want it to be. Roads sometimes run beside creeks, ditches, and even drainage gullies that can swallow your car completely. If you can't escape in time, you could find yourself trapped in a sinking car. Now, more than a few thousand dollars is at stake - it may mean your life!

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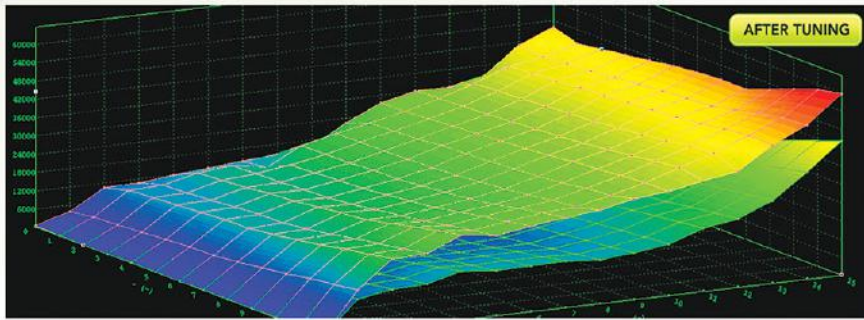

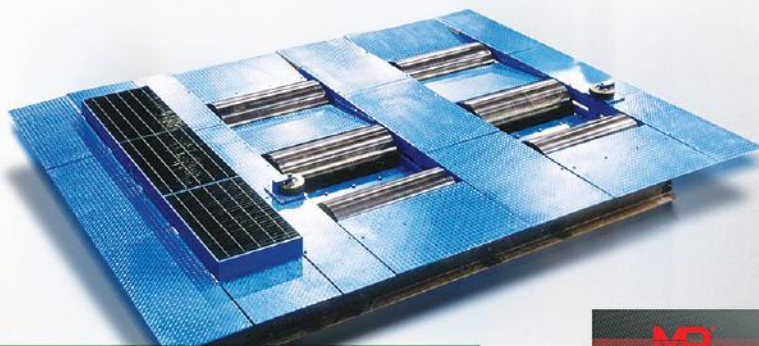

It will pay \$15.76 per share or a 25% premium over Navistar's 90-day volume weighted average price as of August 31, 2016, or 12% over Navistar's closing price on September 2, 2016. Navistar will receive \$256 million from the equity investment to be used for

general corporate purposes.

To underscore the long-term nature of the alliance, Volkswagen Truck & Bus has agreed to hold these shares for a minimum of three years. Reflective of its shareholding post-transaction, Volkswagen Truck & Bus will have the right to appoint two directors to Navistar's board of directors.

Harley-Davidson to Stop Sales of Illegal Devices That Increased Air Pollution from the Company's Motorcycles

WASHINGTON... The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) announced a settlement with Harley-Davidson, Inc., Harley-Davidson Motor Company Group, LLC, Harley-Davidson Motorcycle Company, Inc., and Harley-Davidson Motor Company Operations, Inc. (collectively Harley-Davidson), that requires the companies to stop selling and to buy back and destroy illegal devices that increase air pollution from their motorcycles, and to sell only models of these devices that are certified to meet Clean Air Act emissions standards. Harley-Davidson will also pay a \$12 million civil penalty and spend \$3 million to mitigate air pollution through

a project to replace conventional woodstoves with cleaner-burning stoves in local communities.

The government's complaint, filed along with the settlement, alleges that Harley-Davidson manufactured and sold approximately 340,000 illegal devices, known as "super tuners," that, once installed, caused motorcycles to emit higher amounts of certain air pollutants than what the company certified to EPA. Aftermarket defeat devices like these super tuners alter a motor vehicle's emissions controls and are prohibited under the Clean Air Act for use on vehicles that have been certified to meet EPA emissions standards. Harley-Davidson also made and sold more than 12,000 motorcycles that were not covered

by an EPA certification that ensures a vehicle meets federal clean air standards.

"Given Harley-Davidson's prominence in the industry, this is a very significant step toward our goal of stopping the sale of illegal aftermarket defeat devices that cause harmful pollution on our roads and in our communities," said Assistant Attorney General John C. Cruden, head of the Justice Department's Environment and Natural Resources Division. "Anyone else who manufactures, sells, or installs these types of illegal products should take heed of Harley-Davidson's corrective actions and immediately stop violating the law."

Since January 2008, Harley-Davidson has manufactured and sold two types of tuners, which when

hooked up to Harley-Davidson motorcycles, allow users to modify certain aspects of a motorcycle's emissions control system. These modified settings increase power and performance, but also increase the motorcycle's emissions of hydrocarbons and nitrogen oxides (NOx). These tuners have been sold at Harley-Davidson dealerships across the country.

Under the settlement, Harley-Davidson will stop selling the illegal aftermarket defeat devices in the United States by August 23, 2016. Harley-Davidson will also offer to

buy back all such tuners in stock at Harley-Davidson dealerships across the country and destroy them. The settlement requires the company to obtain a certification from the California Air Resources Board (CARB) for any tuners it sells in the United States in the future. The CARB certification will demonstrate that the CARB-certified tuners do not cause Harley-Davidson's motorcycles to exceed the EPA-certified emissions limits. Harley-Davidson will also conduct tests on motorcycles that have been tuned with the CARB-certified tuners and provide the

results to EPA to ensure that its motorcycles remain in compliance with EPA emissions requirements. In addition, for any super tuners that Harley-Davidson sells outside the United States in the future, it must label them as not for use in the United States.

The complaint also alleges that Harley-Davidson made and sold more than 12,000 motorcycles from model years 2006, 2007 and 2008 that were not covered by an EPA certificate of conformity.

Professional Truck Driver Saves Fellow Driver From Rising Floodwaters - Melton Truck Lines, Inc.'s Daniel Sieczkarski Named Highway Angel For His Heroic Efforts

ALEXANDRIA, VA... Daniel Sieczkarski, of Rochester, New York, a professional driver for Melton Truck Lines, Inc. of Tulsa, Oklahoma, has been named a Highway Angel by the Truckload Carriers Association (TCA). Daniel is being recognized for saving another driver whose tractor trailer was stuck in rising floodwater.

On April 18, 2016, Sieczkarski was driving on I-10 near Brookshire, TX just outside of Houston, when he heard the weather channel warning broadcast alert of flooding in the area. Shortly after he noticed a tractor trailer parked sideways in floodwater near the bridge with the driver behind the wheel. Immediately Sieczkarski knew something wasn't right. He quickly moved his truck to a safe place and ran back to check on the driver. "I had never seen flooding before so I didn't realize how bad it was until I got closer," said Sieczkarski. As he gazed upon the scene, he realized how close the floodwater was rising around the driver and his truck.

Sieczkarski borrowed a life vest and some tubing from a motorist that had also stopped. Together they tied the tubing to the vest and sent it down for the driver to use himself. After 15 minutes of talking with the driver, who was hesitant to leave his tractor trailer and all his belongings, Sieczkarski knew he had to take matters into his own hands. Sieczkarski put the life vest on himself and swam to the stranded driver's truck. When he opened the cab door, the driver could see how quickly the water was rising and was convinced to leave his truck and together they began swimming to safety. The motorists lent support by keeping hold of the tubing to help in the rescue. Together they were submerged in the fast rising water several times but ended up getting to dryer land safely and unharmed. An hour after Sieczkarski decided to put another man's life before his own, he heard over the radio that the stranded tractor trailer was fully submerged under

the water. If he had not acted so quickly the outcome could have been very different. Sieczkarski and the other driver talk on a regular basis; the rescued driver and his wife are both thankful that Sieczkarski made the quick decision to help that day.

Sieczkarski has been driving for 14 years and enjoys his job because he's able to drive across the beautiful country. When asked about what made him risk his own life for a stranger he said, "I lost my wife three years ago and I didn't know if that driver had a wife and family, but if he did, I didn't want his family to go through what I had gone through."

For his willingness to help, TCA has presented Sieczkarski with a certificate, patch, lapel pin, and truck decals. Melton Truck Lines, Inc. also received a certificate acknowledging Sieczkarski as a Highway Angel.
